

New Territory Sports

Policies and Procedures

Eligibility

New Territory residents must be in good standing with New Territory Homeowner's Association. Residents must show proof of residency that will be kept on file. Non-residents will be charged an additional facility fee. The Club reserves the right to perform random eligibility checks on any participant.

Registration Process

Registrations are accepted by phone, email, mail, fax, and in person at The Club in New Territory. All fees are required at the time of registration and can be paid using cash, checks, or credit cards with no additional fees. Age cut-off dates will be adhered to. Players interested in playing up must gain the approval of the Athletic Coordinator. Late registrations are charged \$15. A waiting list will be compiled when team rosters are full.

Refunds

Refunds will only be given for medical reasons with a doctor's excuse, in the event of relocation, or if The Club should elect to cancel the program. A refund will not be given due to an inability to make the assigned practice time or game. If unsportsmanlike conduct should cause a player to be ejected from game or league, no refund will be given.

League Formation

The goal in league formation is to create teams that are equal in playing ability. Teams are formed based on age, experience, skill, height, evaluation and drafting by Athletic Coordinator or coaches. In rare circumstances, co-ed or changes in age range will occur.

Practices

Youth Sports practice times will be scheduled by the Athletic Coordinator. Youth Sport practice days vary by league. Full 10 week leagues have practices on weekdays with games on Saturdays. Mini-leagues have practices *and* games on weekdays. Please see individual informational flyer for specific league dates. Some league practices may start as early as 4 pm or end as late as 10:00 pm. Adult Sports have no scheduled practices.

Game Schedules

Game schedules will be developed by the Athletic Coordinator. Some league games may start as early as 7:30 am or end as late as 9:30 pm. Please see individual informational flyer for specific league days/times. Games may be cancelled or rescheduled for weather or other unforeseen circumstance (such as equipment failure, referee schedules, etc).

Forfeitures

Any team that does not have the minimum number of players by 10 minutes after the official start time of the game forfeits. The remaining time is used for scrimmage. If games are behind schedule, this time is used to get the remaining games back on track.

Unacceptable Behavior

Any person in violation of New Territory Club and League Rules or the parent/coach pledge will be subject to discipline measures. Discipline measures may include fines, warnings, probation, suspension, or expulsion from league and/or future leagues.
